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POTENTIAL MENTORING PROPOSALS

KA1: Mobility - Youth Exchanges

Duration	From 5 to 21 days excluding travel time.
Participants	Young people aged between 13 and 30. Group leaders involved in the Youth Exchange must be at least 18 years old. In total, minimum 16 and maximum of 60 participants + group leaders. Per country minimum 4 participants per group + group leader.
Budget	Covers the transport and give a fixed amount per day x country.
Application	- 30th April at 12:00: for projects starting between 1st August and 31st December. - 1st October at 12:00: for projects starting between 1st January and 31st May.

Project example

Youth experience exchange within mentors of different country organizations in the field of social mentoring.

KA1: Mobility - Training courses

Duration	From 2 days to 2 months, excluding travel time.
Participants	Youth workers. Older than 18th, there is no age limit. Up to 50 participants (including, where relevant, trainers and facilitators) in each activity planned by the project.
Budget	Covers the transport and give a fixed amount per day per country, the given budget per participant is higher than the Youth exchanges in order to cover the cost of the trainers.
Application	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- 30th April at 12:00: for projects starting between 1st August and 31st December.- 1st October at 12:00: for projects starting between 1st January and 31st May.

Project example

Course directed to the professionals working within the mentoring programmes, as an exchange of practices and learning of improvement tools.

KA2: Exchange of good practices

What is it?	The goal is to reinforce networks, by exchanging ideas, practices and methods. They have to produce tangible outputs and disseminate the results of their activities.
Participation & Duration	Minimum three organisations from three different Programme Countries. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Partnerships in the field of higher education: between 24 and 36 months.• Partnerships in the youth field: between 6 and 36 months.
Budget	Fixed amount for management costs + covers the mobilities + accommodation + meals.
Application	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Higher education: 24th of March• Youth: 30th of April and 1st of October

Project example

Two years project within the country members in order to exchange management methodologies of the mentoring programmes. Creation of a joint manual.

KA2: Cooperation for innovation

What is it?	Project should develop innovative outputs , this means creating newly produced products or innovative ideas.
Participation & Duration	Minimum three organisations from three different Programme Countries. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Partnerships in the field of higher education: between 24 and 36 months.• Partnerships in the youth field: between 6 and 36 months.
Budget	There is a fixed amount per worked day for each intellectual output. + Management costIt covers the potential study visits / training courses and youth exchanges in the project.
Application	- 30th April at 12:00: for projects starting between 1st August and 31st December. - 1st October at 12:00: for projects starting between 1st January and 31st May.

Project example

Two to three years programme in order to develop natural mentoring tools, create a shared quality mechanism and integrate measurement tools for mentor skills evaluation for the curricula.

KA3: Policy dialogue

What is it?	Youth Dialogue projects can take the form of meetings, conferences, consultations and events. Promoting the active participation of young to interact with the decision makers.
Participation & Duration	Minimum of two organisations from at least two different countries Involvement of minimum 30 participants aged from 13 to 30 years old.
Budget	There is covered the transport and organizational support for the mobility actions. There is no budget for management costs.
Application	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- 30th April at 12:00: for projects starting between 1st August and 31st December.- 1st October at 12:00: for projects starting between 1st January and 31st May.

Project example

Invite a little sample of mentors and mentees in a certain planned transnational mentoring event (European Mentoring Summit?) to discuss with policy makers the impact of social mentoring.

European Solidarity Corps

What is it?	Youth Dialogue projects can take the form of meetings, conferences, consultations and events. Promoting the active participation of young to interact with the decision makers.
Participation & Duration	Volunteering activities take place from 2 to 12 months. Participants should be aged from 18 to 30 years old.
Budget	There is a given budget for pocket money, travel costs, accomodation and meals.
Application	First procedure: apply any time for the Quality Level Certification Afterwards there are left two application deadlines: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 30th of April and 1st of October 2020.

Project example

Host an European volunteer (past mentor from one of the programmes) to support another organization's mentoring programme.
